


RRBC still considers in-basin options to be the most consistent with its Guiding Principles and NRFP goals and objectives. However, if an out of basin alternative is ultimately selected, in order to address downstream interests, that alternative must include a multi-barrier biota treatment facility that meets the treatment goals for the preferred alternative as described in the Supplementary Draft EIS.
